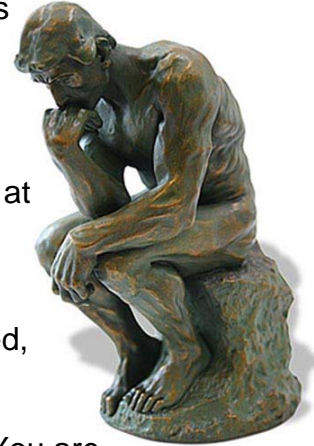


A CLASSIC DOORSTOP
