Glen Travis Campbell, born on April 22, 1936, is a Grammy, Dove Award-winning and two-time-nominated Golden Globe American country pop singer, guitarist and occasional actor. He is best known for a series of hits in the 1960s and 1970s, as well as for hosting a television variety show called the Glen Campbell Goodtime Hour on CBS television.

During his 50 years in show business, Campbell has released more than 70 million albums, sold 45 million records, and racked up 12 Gold albums, 4 Platinum albums and 1 Double-Platinum album.



Let me be a little braver When temptation bids me waiver Let me strive a little harder To be all that I should be.

And a little less of me.
