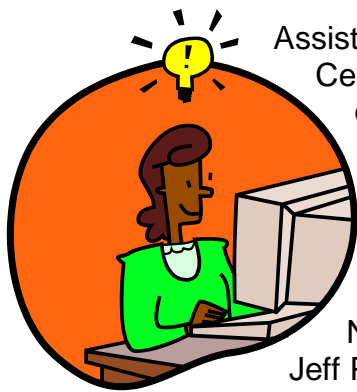


# Bright Young Leaders
