Before leaving the building, however, driver Skip Schmidt discovered that the van had a bad tire and delayed the shipment to repair it.

While the tire was being fixed, a member of Shepard's Way Baptist Church arrived with 17 shoe boxes, exactly enough to make the goal of 1,000.

"We were so excited to share our story with her," said Vickie Menzie, activities coordinator at Life Care Center of Citrus County. "If the van tire had not been in need of repair, we would have missed these boxes. She was so touched, and we all knew God had a hand in this. We held hands in the activities room and prayed, thanking God and asking His blessing on the children these boxes would go to – all 1,000!"
