In September 2000, the city of LaGrange, Georgia, became the first city in the world to offer free Internet access for all its residents and businesses. LaGrange, located 60 miles southwest of Atlanta, gained international attention when it gave its 27,000 citizens free access through their cable television network. The city provides all the necessary hardware, software and access at no cost to the public.

The World Teleport Association of New York honored LaGrange with the "Intelligent City of the Year" award for 2000. *Government Technology* magazine also applauded the city by bestowing its "Government Technology Leadership" award.
